The planning efforts of the Village Council and my office are starting to pay off and your patience is appreciated during construction to complete the projects underway.

The East Washington Street resurfacing began on April 24th. The scope of the project includes some sidewalk and driveway approaches being replacement. The street is expected to remain open. We ask that you do NOT park on the street. This project is expected to be completed by Memorial Day.

The Danford Park Restroom Project will break ground in May. A rendering was posted on our official Facebook page – Village of Dimondale. The installation is expected to be completed no-later-than August 2023.

There are some great community events in the coming weeks to include the Spring Farmer's Market on May 13th, a Memorial Day Parade on May 29th, and the Annual Oldsmobile Car Show on June 16th. More information on page 2.

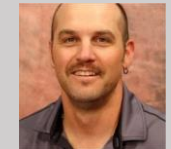

Zoning and Building Permits

The Permit process begins at the Village Offices. A transmittal is required from the Village to Eaton County verifying the request meets our ordinances.

You or your hired company need to be aware of the Village Zoning Ordinances and also know when a permit is needed.

Here are some of the most common reasons you need an Eaton County Building Permit, that starts here in the Village Office:

- New Homes/Business
- Additions to existing structures
- Decks and ramps
- Pools
- Residential Accessory Structures over 200 sqft
- Demos of homes or out buildings
- Interior alterations where there is drywall being replaced, framing, new walls, subfloor, truss/rafter/beam work, insulation.
- Re-roof that requires more than two sheets of decking to be removed
