### Treasurer's Report

The October 31, 2025 treasurer's report was filed with no corrections.

## **Bills**

The bills were reviewed. Motion by Campbell, second Tardino, to approve payment of \$120,585.34 in the General Fund, \$24.96 in the Major Street Fund, and \$221.16 in the Farmers' Market Fund for October 31, 2025 bills and transfers. Motion carried.

#### **Unfinished Business**

Troy Dean, 109 W. Jefferson St., provided an update on the Special Use Permit issued in June 2021. Discussion followed regarding work completed and time frame for compliance. Dean proposed to have siding on the Bridge Street side of the building completed within the next thirty days and the remainder of the exterior work done within six months. Tiedeman stated that she continues to see improvement and has no concerns with the proposed timeframes. Motion by Campbell, second J. Bowen, to allow Dean to continue working toward compliance with a report due to Council in six months. Motion carried.

### **New Business**

- 1. Bowen presented a Resolution to authorize Matt Bowen, Ralph Reznick and Danielle Tiedeman to negotiate an offer to purchase property. Motion by J. Bowen, second Haidamous, to approve the Resolution. Motion carried unanimously. (Copy attached.)
- 2. Reznick presented a recommendation from the Public Works Committee to prohibit parking on Walnut Street. Motion by Haidamous, second J. Bowen, to prohibit parking on Walnut Street, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. not during the summer. Discussion followed regarding traffic congestion, enforcement challenges and notifying residents in advance for input. Haidamous and J. Bowen withdrew their motions. Motion by Haidamous, second Tardino, to table the issue until resident notification. Motion carried.
- 3. Reznick presented a recommendation from the Public Works Committee to eliminate the parking space adjacent to the pedestrian crosswalk on W. Jefferson Street. Reznick explained that a review of State Law indicated that it is illegal to park within 20' of a crosswalk which may result in the loss of more parking spots in the area. Motion by Conarton, second M. Bowen, to remove parking spots that are in violation of State Law and make them fire lanes. Motion carried.

4. Reznick introduced the MML annual membership for consideration. Motion by Campbell, second M. Bowen, to renew the membership but decline participation in the Legal Defense Fund. Motion carried.
