Protecting Our Corner of the Watershed

Use Native Vegetation and Eliminate Turf Grass

Landscaping with Michigan native wildflowers and grasses improves the environment and brings a taste of wilderness to urban, suburban and commercial settings by attracting a variety of birds, butterflies and bees. Once established, native plants do not need fertilizers, herbicides, pesticides or watering thereby improving the environment and reducing maintenance costs. Select plants that have low requirements for water, fertilizers and pesticides. Cultivate plants that discourage pests. Minimize grassed areas which require high maintenance. Use landscaping techniques such as porous walkways to increase infiltration and decrease runoff.
